


Susan Shelley, Orange County Register Columnist and Activist

They will review, discuss and select the projects to be funded. **Item 2 Goals and Objectives** Provide seed money or funding for special projects involving, for example: • Political issue education • Club membership development through events or communications • Media relations training (ie., speaking to the media, public speaking)
